

<u>HOW TO ADD AN ATTACHMENT TO A REPORT IN RMS</u>

Witness statements, photos, insurance documents, search warrants, crime lab results are only a few of the things you may want to add to a report. You can either create a supplement report that is dedicated to these types of attachments or attach them to the original report, and there is no wrong or right way, it just depends on how your agency conducts business.

I have found that one area is being under-utilized for attachments. Did you know that you can go to the CASE TAB of any report and add them there? No extra document needed.



Hit the + sign and attach. You will also see all and any other documents that are included in the case and included with the original report, supplements, crashes, arrests all in one location. NEW APX RADIOS

Our XTS radio fleet first hit the streets Warren County in late 1990s/ early 2000s. Beginning with this new fleet of radios, this should last us at least until 2030. Our new Motorola APX radios have features that include Bluetooth capability, Active Noise canceling for audio transmission, Dual screens for more usability. Many more features that far surpass the XTS line of radios we were using.

Telecom has begun to deploy Motorola APX portable radios to replace all County owned public safety XTS portable radios and will be working with departments on updating programming as needed for APX radios.
